# our heroes providers in action

Many of you contribute to the wellness of your communities. You also participate in, and lend your expertise to, national and international organizations that help others. We're interested in what you're doing. When you pay it forward by donating time, supplies and funds to others, you're using your talents and good fortune to improve the lives of others. No matter how you define it, helping others is heroic, and we believe it does make a difference.

Meet our hero, Dr. Bernard Fialkoff, who runs a thriving practice in Bayside, N.Y., specializing in modern dental implantology, periodontics and cosmetic laser surgery. He joined our network in March 2000. In addition to being a successful periodontist, Dr. Fialkoff is a born educator and mentor.

He served as a clinical instructor at Flushing Hospital Medical Center and became a featured lecturer for Spanish American Medical Congresses, Queens Academy of General Dentistry meetings and the State University of New York Stony Brook Dental School. He also was secretary of the Spanish American Study Club and held a two-day implant/periodontology

surgical course for the Dominican Republic Study Group. In 1995, Dr. Fialkoff founded Fialkoff Queens Dental Study Club. He is director of the club's implant certainty training program, offering attending practitioners the opportunity for CE credits.

Dr. Fialkoff and his study club participants have long considered embarking on a humanitarian trip. So last year, after some discussion, they decided on Havana, Cuba. To prepare, Dr. Fialkoff and his daughter, Meghan, director of the U.S.-Cuba Dental Humanitarian Trip, visited the University of Havana Dental School this spring. Dr. Fialkoff has always dreamed of going back to Havana. His parents left Russia during World War II and settled in Havana, where he was born. Then when Dr. Fialkoff was about 10 years old, they moved to Connecticut.

With U.S. travel restrictions to Cuba, the Fialkoffs had to apply for a humanitarian project license through the U.S. Treasury Department for the trip, which can take months. In the mean time, they ventured to Havana to meet with the Ministry of Health and University of Havana Dental School to learn more about how to bring donations to the country. Global Health Partners helped arrange the trip, having brought medical groups and donations to Cuba for decades. Cuba is the most populated country in the Caribbean with more than 11 million people, and the majority of Cubans speak Spanish. In addition to the rich culture and architecture, many Cubans drive cars from the 1950s. After the U.S. trade embargo on Cuba in the late '50s, trade was very difficult, so Cubans smartly cared for these cars and still drive them today.

When the official trip is scheduled, at least 30 dental practitioners and staff volunteers will travel to Havana, with visas in hand, to provide dental supply donations and help those in need. Now all they need are supplies — a lot of supplies — everything from gloves and masks to portable units and drills. A dental supply manufacturing company recently pledged to donate supplies, but there's still a long way to go. The amount of care the volunteer dentists can provide to the Havana community hinges on the amount of donated supplies they can bring from the U.S. Although health care, medical technology and education in Cuba are highly ranked, there is still a U.S. trade embargo, the government still rations goods and supplies are always in demand.

Dr. Fialkoff shares that, "Helping each other and realizing we're all on the same ship called Earth is a great way of looking at life. Sometimes you can get lost in the hecticness and busy pace of just trying to survive, but I think it's always very important to realize that without our fellow man, very little would ever exist.

"That's why we have a purpose in our office to help not only with teeth, but with humanitarian efforts and mankind in general. Hopefully, when you read this you will decide to do the same. Thank you.
